In one or two years, you are awarded an MSc in International Finance. The General track equips you with up-to-date broad knowledge of international finance across various finance disciplines.

- **Choose your track** – Choose which field of finance you want to focus on. We offer a General track, focussing on broader financial areas, and a Fintech track where you work on assessing and managing financial risks, using all available data and tools.

Students can take up to two additional extracurricular elective courses during the programme.

The curriculum is subject to change.

Full-time course load

Full-time students typically attend 3-4 evening classes per week. Classes take 9-12 hours per week. Class preparation, casework and assignments usually require a further 18-27 hours per week.

Part-time course load

For part-time students, the programme is spread over a period of 24 months. Students usually attend 1-2 evening classes per week, for a total of 3-6 hours. Class preparation, casework and assignments typically require an additional 6-9 hours per week.

International study trip

The international study trip to South Africa is designed to introduce you to an additional dimension of international finance markets. Understanding this emerging market and society in transition is important to anyone who is interested in investment and business opportunities in other countries.

Small classes

To help develop your skills as a finance specialist, we keep class sizes deliberately small. Professors can focus on individual students, guiding them personally towards their specific goals, while learners bounce ideas off one another during interactive seminars and lectures. We believe learning is a dialogue, not a monologue.

Diversity

We welcome applicants from all over the world. Combined with a mix of full-time students, working part-timers and an international faculty, this makes for an exciting melting pot of cultures, professional backgrounds and academic skills.

Speaker events

Experts in various areas of finance, big data and leadership are invited to speak on topics of interest to MIF students on a regular basis. These are held every quarter during the academic year. They aim to serve as inspiration and provide networking opportunities for students, alumni, friends, colleagues, and other interested members of the community.

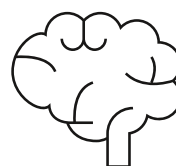

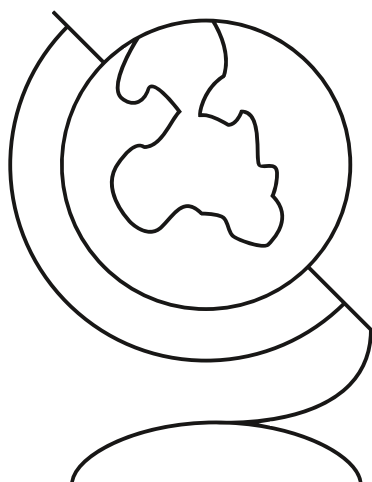
